

OUR DESIRED OUTCOMES

Four outcomes continually feed into one-another to cultivate our MB disciple-making ecosystem.



Outcome one: Discipling identity

We require a defined description of a disciple of Jesus, framed by biblical and theological convictions. This outcome will help us identify a disciple's characteristics and behaviours, giving us a clearer focus on developing training and programs. To design language around discipling identity, we envision creating books, articles, videos and producing preaching and teaching resources in the next few years.



Outcome two: Churches that disciple

This outcome identifies, supports and enhances the work of churches that have a clear disciple-making pathway. The vision here is for church-based programs and training that cultivates disciples of Jesus as described in Outcome one. We see internships, mentoring, partnerships and apprenticeships taking place in as many churches as possible. We also envision a strong connection with the global church by fostering meaningful partnering and DNA exchange.


Outcome four:
